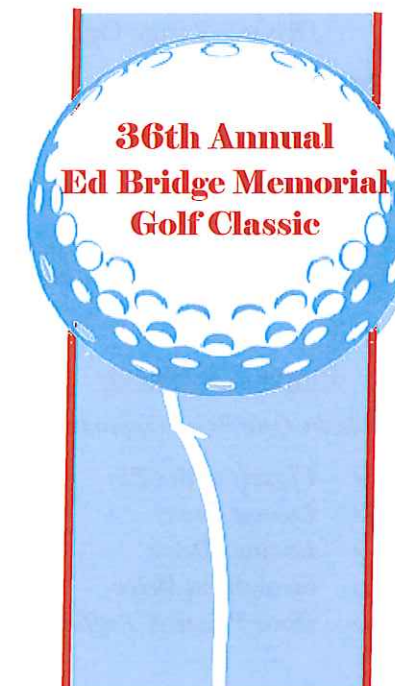
Garden State Council Program Highlights

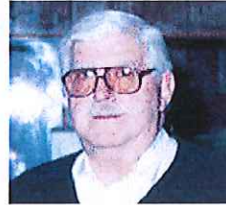
